

RULES TO LIVE BY ON THE



In order to assure the comfort and safety of all aboard this vessel, experience teaches us to follow certain rules.

Life jackets shall be worn on deck by all aboard after dark, outside the Golden Gate Bridge, and by all non-swimmers and children under 12.

Close and secure all watertight doors below decks when underway.

Sturdy, closed toe shoes must be worn by all on duty – and they are strongly recommended for guests as well.

Lighters or open flames are not to be used onboard without prior approval of the Skipper

Ask permission of the Officer of the Deck to visit the bridge. A maximum of four people may occupy the bridge at the discretion of the Officer of the Deck.

Clean up after yourself – especially the heads. If you do not know how to operate the heads (toilets) please ask for a demonstration. *“Clean enough to be healthy and dirty enough to be comfortable”*

Face the ladders and back down step by step maintaining a firm grip on the handrails *“One hand for yourself and one hand for the ship”*

DO NOT...

Do not run, jump, or play on the deck.

Do not jump from one deck to another.

Do not sit on the handrails—especially when the Northland is underway
